Dr. M. Arundhathi

Born in Chittoor of Andhra Pradesh in 1934. Dr. M. Arundhathi has had a meritorious journey in her career. A topper in matriculation examination and a gold medalist both in undergraduate and postgraduate studies, Dr. Arundhathi is the first lady to graduate from Guntur Medical College. Having completed her DGO and MD in Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Dr. Arundhathi joined Karnataka State Medical Service in 1961. Serving the needy in various designations at four esteemed Medical Colleges of Bangalore, Mysore, Hubli, and Bellary, Dr. Arundhathi continued her service to the medical field as a professor from 1966. During the Indo-Pakistani War of 1971, she contributed to her mother nation by volunteering to serve the front line of the army and offered medical aid to people who were critically ill and in need of care. A noble medical professional and a great patriot that she is, Dr. Arundhathi has helped many patients facing life-threatening illness. A sincere medical practitioner, Dr. Arundhathi has never missed an opportunity when it came to lending her helping hand to the needy. She has served in many medical camps all

over the state coordinated by several organizations including Bihar Blind Relief Camp in 1956, the Lions Club, Rotary Club, Inner-wheel club, and Institute of World Culture. During her days as a professor at Bellary Medical College, she spent most of the weekends serving in the neighboring villages and agricultural Camps that were deprived of medical facilities.

The firsts of Dr. Arundhathi:

Coming to the aid of the underprivileged, she herself has organized several medical camps and has been actively involved in various social organizations. For her industrious work with an aptitude to research, Dr. Arundhathi was honored as the president of the Inner-wheel Club at Bellary in 1971-72. Adored by her students for her ingenuity she was selected as an undergraduate and post-graduate examiner at several medical colleges across South India. Her undaunted care and affection to her patients made her one of the most sought after doctors during her time. Dr. Arundhathi is the first to perform Radical Hysterectomy and other radical surgeries for Cancer during days when people were unaware of diathermy. During her time as the professor of gynecology at the Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, she established a strong Department of Gynaecological Oncology that served infinite patients.

Dr. Arundhathi - A true optimist!!

Her contributions to the medical community earned her a W.H.O Fellowship in 1974 to visit several European countries and establish the practice of MTP in India. At the age of 45, when she had reached the pinnacle of her career, Dr. Arundhathi met with a frightful accident in 1979 that left her shattered with a head and cervical spine injury causing quadriplegia.

However, this mishap didn't deter her sheer strong will. She surprised the best of medical experts by getting back on her feet and was able to use her left hand in a span of 6 months. She rejoined the work at Kidwai institute and started seeing about 50 outpatients every day. However a few days later, due to the medical reasons she was compelled to voluntarily retire as a medical practitioner at Kidwal.Dr. Arundhathi, unaffected by the series of unfavourable situations has always been a person of strong will. She continued to teach as an Honorary Professor at Kempe Gowda Medical College till the college got recognised by the MCI. She actively indulged herself in lecturing and tutored several undergraduate and post-graduate students at her home.

Recognitions and Honor:

An author of several mythological and spiritual books, Dr. Arundhathi is a recipient


of several awards including Dr. B.C. Roy Doctor's Day award. Along with her husband Dr. R.S.K. Murthy she established A.V. Hospital at Basavanagudi, Bangalore in 1980 where she continued to treat patients for several decades. She made sure a temple was constructed in the hospital premises and from the time of her service till today, the patients swear by her and trust her methods and techniques as a doctor. Her idea of an ethical and costeffective hospital helps common people afford medical assistance. Despite health issues, Dr. Arundhathi chooses to be active. She is a great disciplinarian who starts her day at 3 am with meditation and continues to write "Ramanamas" with her left hand. She is not only an inspiration to her family, but an eminent personality to be recognized, appreciated, and acknowledged by the society for her innumerable contributions to the medical world.



Dr. Makam Ramesh has the distinction of having established the first video laparoscopoic surgery centre in a private setup in Karnataka State almost three decades ago, at A.V. Hospital, Bangalore. Almost 40 different types of advanced laparoscopic surgeries were performed by him for the first time in the State. Dr. Saraswathi Ramesh has established the finest Minimal Invasive Gynaecological surgery Centre. Thousands of patients with infertility, fibroids, endometriosis and other gynaecological ailments including cancer have been successfully treated here.

A.V. Hospital is the only hospital in South India to be recognised by both Hernia Society of India as well as Asia Pacific Hernia Society as a 'Centre of Excellence". It has remained the premiere centre in the field of laparoscopic surgery with more

than 30,000 minimal invasive surgeries being performed here. Over 1500 surgeons and gynaecologists from all parts of India as well as from 5 continents have been trained in laparoscopic surgical skills here.

Certificate Course for Laparoscopic Training Course

A.V. Hospital & BEST Institute conducted 3 more batches of its popular Certificate Course for Laparoscopic Training Course. A total of 22 doctors were trained in these 3 batches. Both national and international doctors took part in this training batches. Trainees had a hands on training around 50 hours in the skills lab and performed various tasks on the Institute developed Pelvitrainer. Endoscopic suturing sessions were also included. Weekly assessment of

improvement in laparoscopy skills were assessed by pelvitrainer tests. A total of 88 cases were demonstrated during these training sessions. All the trainees were given hands on experience in assisting and performing surgical procedures from basic diagnostic to operative procedures. They witnessed a variety of cases like Diagnostic Hysteroscopy, Hysteroscopic Myomectomy, Total Laparoscopic Hysterectomy, Lap Myomectomy, Lap Ovarian Cystectomy, Lap Ectopic surgery, Lap Cholecystectomy, TEP and TAPP for Inguinal hernia, Lap IPOM Plus for Ventral hernia, Adhesiolysis, Lap orchidopexy for Undescended testis, Lap Appendicectomy. A total of 88 cases were demonstrated during these training sessions.

The training course included Live Operative demonstrations, Endotrainer sessions on different modules, & Didactic sessions. Internationally renowned faculty were part

of this didactic sessions, which was transmitted through teleconferencing which was conducted flawlessly.
